Dear all,

As the CAHP Project moves forward, we continually receive feedback on the features released and any unexpected 'behaviour' of the system.

In order to transition to the new solution, existing data needs to be amended and that can have downstream impacts. We are committed to maintaining close communications with Schools during this time given the tight timeframes associated with this project: which is why I have been encouraged to speak directly to School Managers and Administrators of the system, and not route the communications through Tim Dunne as the academic sponsor and chair of the Steering Committee.

Below is a summary of the important issues that have been raised and the resolution status.
